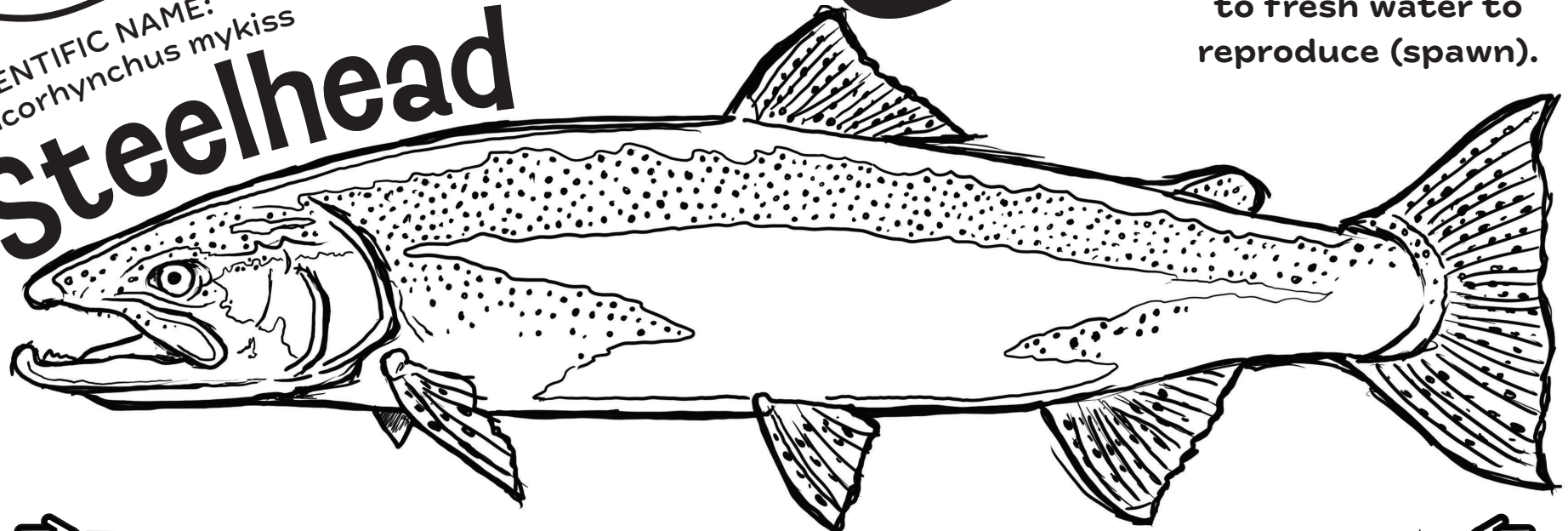

 a STEELHEAD is a RAINBOW TROUT that navigates to the ocean to grow and feed, then it migrates back to fresh water to reproduce (spawn).

One Colorful Fish!

In the ocean, steelhead are bright silver/chrome, but when they return to fresh water, steelhead turn **dark-olive green**, with a **silvery-white** belly, speckled bodies and a **pinkish-red** stripe running along their sides. Use your art supplies to color the steelhead's body.



Steelhead migration ranges from Eastern Russia to Alaska, and down the Pacific Coast of the U.S., going inland in the Pacific Northwest. That's a LOT of swimming!
